The European course will give a wide range of ideas how you can include the active use of video within your language lessons. You will get ideas, pedagogical and digital video production support in order to facilitate your students to get this exiting work.

The course will be hands on - explore fascinating places of the historical and new Berlin with a video camera. Joint discussions will make sure that we can find the best ideas for your specific teaching environment. We offer European teacher training since 2002.

Who is the course for?

The course is open for all teachers, teacher trainers, head teachers, teaching assistants and curriculum developers from across Europe.

Where does the course help?

The ideas offered are close to your students' interests (just think of how popular YouTube is among young people), will bring in new motivation to learn a foreign language and also support independent learning. The ideas are based on working in small teams within realistic video projects. They can also contribute to your school development especially in the area of ICT.
